Mayor Corrie led the Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Alderman Eades, seconded by Alderman Mitze, to approve the Claims Report for August 8, 2011, City Council meeting minutes for May 9, June 27, July 11, and July 25, 2011. Also the Treasurer's Report for June 30, 2011. Motion Carried 8-0

In the Mayor's Report, Mayor Corrie stated that the city and the township have been working together on a few projects.

A motion was made by Alderman Mitze, seconded by Alderman Brown to Approve Ordinance 2011-32. This ordinance approves the updates to the Municipal Codes through American Legal. Motion Carried. 8-0

A motion was made by Alderman Hayes, seconded by Alderman Cummings, to approve Ordinance 2011-33. This ordinance would approve the Monticello Main Street to provide a libation area on the square for an additional night. They would like to sell alcohol both Friday and Saturday. Motion Carried 4-4 with Mayor Corrie breaking the tie.

A motion was made by Alderman Hayes, seconded by Alderman Mitze, to approve Resolution 2011-34. This resolution approves a project site for Piatt County Facilities to be financed under the Public Building Commission Act. Motion Carried 8-0.

In Alderman Reports, Alderman Hayes stated that 25,214 people have attended the pool this year. There are 2,074 pool passes.

A motion was made by Alderman Kuetemeyer, seconded by Alderman Hayes to adjourn to closed session at 8:24pm.
